• Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP)

• Training and Research in Frontier Areas of Science and Technology (FAST)

• All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has a scheme of funding Research Parks in collaboration with industry in AICTE approved institutions

• University Grants Commission (UGC) has also rolled out flagship schemes which aim to promote quality and excellence in the field of education sector, namely, Universities with Potential for Excellence (UPE), Centre with Potential for Excellence in Particular Area (CPEPA) and Colleges with Potential for Excellence and College of Excellence (CPE/CE)
