(a) to (e): The Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) is the highest advisory body to advise the Central and State Governments in the field of education. CABE has an important role to play, particularly in view of significant socio-economic and socio-cultural developments taking place in the country as also the wide ranging reforms taking place in the education sector. On expiry of the tenure on 17th May, 2015, CABE has been reconstituted vide Resolution No.2-18/2011-PN-I dated 11th June, 2015 for a period of three years with effect from the date of its notification. A list of members of CABE is annexed. A meeting of the reconstituted CABE is scheduled for 19th August, 2015.
