(a) & (b): No. Madam. This Ministry had convened a meeting with the State Education Ministers/Principal Secretaries (Education) on 6th January, 2015 at Vigyan Bhavan, New Delhi in which Choice-based Credit System (CBCS) was also discussed. A consensus emerged during the meeting on the implementation of CBCS across the universities and colleges from the academic session 2015-16. The University Grants Commission (UGC) further convened 8 workshops with universities and colleges across the country to deliberate on the implementation of CBCS from the academic session 2015-16. The UGC had also set up a cell, in its headquarters, to look into challenges emanating from CBCS and for helping higher educational institutions in its implementation.
