Allegation on Terrorism

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the false allegations being leveled by Pakistan on India about patronizing terrorism;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the action taken by the Government against such false allegations by Pakistan?

(a) to (c) Government is aware that Pakistani officials have been indulging in hostile propaganda against India in order to divert international attention from its continued policy of sponsoring terrorism against India. The international community recognizes Pakistan's continued support for cross border terrorism directed against India. The Al Qaeda and Taliban Sanctions Committee, under the UN's Security Council Resolution 1267 has already listed several individual entities based in Pakistan including the leaders of the Laskhar e Tayyiba (LeT) responsible for the Mumbai terror attacks. Pakistan based Jamat-ud Dawa has also been listed as an alias of the LeT.
