- (a) & (b): As reported by the Government of Uttar Pradesh (UP), the area on which slum colonies are spread has been estimated at 397 sq. km. and the percentage of slum area against the total area is 7.42%.
- (c): As per Census 2011, the slum population in the State of Uttar Pradesh is 62,39,965.
- (d): No, Madam.
- (e): Government has launched the "Housing for All (Urban)" Mission on 25.6.2015. The Mission aims to provide assistance to States/UTs including the State of UP in addressing the housing requirement of the slum dwellers and urban poor.
