- (a) and (b) The Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). However, it is learnt that such experiment has taken place on Yamuna Expressway between Noida & Agra which is not a NH.
- (c) and (d) Recently, discussions were held on necessity for setting up emergency landing facilities along major NH corridor for fixed wing Aircraft between this Ministry, Ministry of Defence and Air Force. The proposal is still at consultation stage.
