(a) whether the Government is aware that the State Government of Uttarakhand has been in the process of constructing four flyovers on National Highway No. 72 in Dehradun area;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) the date on which approval was given to the Uttarakhand Government for construction of these flyovers along with the tenders awarded and the work started construction of these flyovers; and

(d) the present status of construction of these flyovers?

(a) to (d) The construction of four flyovers on NH-72 has been undertaken by the State Government out of their own funds under Special Plan Assistance and the tender was awarded for all the four flyovers in December 2013 by the State Government on their own. However, conditional N.O.C. was granted by this Ministry on 15th April 2014 for construction of 4-lane flyovers at ISBT Chowk, Balliwala Chowk, Jogiwala Chowk & 2-lane flyover at Ballupur Chowk in confirmation of the specifications applicable for flyovers on National Highways. Presently, the work with respect to flyovers at ISBT Chowk, Balliwala Chowk and Ballupur Chowk are in progress since December 2013.
