(d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which the work regarding the expansion of this National Highway is likely to be started; and

(e) whether the said Highway is likely to be linked with NH-65 at Churu road by constructing the by-pass instead of constructing it through Raigarh, if so, the survey conducted in this regard?

(a) and (b) Expansion of National Highway (NH) network is a continuous process and declaration of new NH is taken from time to time depending upon requirement of connectivity, inter-se priority and availability of funds.

(c) and (d) Yes, Madam. Ministry vide gazette notification number S.O. 312 (E) dated 22.02.2012 has declared Extension of NH 709 upto Rajgarh. The State Government of Rajasthan has started preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the stretch of NH falling within the State of Rajasthan.
