(a) to (d) This Ministry is primarily responsible for development and maintenance of National Highways (NHs). As such, this Ministry does not maintain any details of the transborder highways in India for the carriage of tradable goods including the details of ongoing projects in such highways.

This Ministry does not allocate any separate funds for construction of transborder highways in India.
