(b)&(c): The Opencast mines under the command area of Coal India Ltd are being operated with various technologies suitable in the coalfields in India. New and modern technology has been adopted to the extent practicable for maximum extraction of coal economically with due regard to safety, conservation, environment and other aspects. Mega opencast projects have been planned with higher size of equipment for excavation, transportation, drilling and other auxiliary operations of international standard. Feasibility of deploying of Continuous miners (CMs) has been considered for mass production technology & Long Wall Mining where ever geo mining conditions permit. A road map has been prepared by CIL for providing adequate man power keeping in mind future growth of the company.

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
