## Will the Minister of HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there has been an increase in the turnover of various Central Public Sector Enterprises in the country during the last three years;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the percentage of the turnover compared to the Gross Domestic Product of the country during each of the last three years; and
- (d) the steps taken by the Government to improve the performance of loss-making State-owned companies?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR HEAVY INDUSTRIES AND PUBLIC ENTERPRISES (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

- (a) & (b), Yes, Madam. The turnover of Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) for the last 3 years i.e. 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13 was Rs. 1498018 crore, Rs. 1822049 crore and Rs. 1945777 crore respectively.
- (c): The contribution of gross value addition of CPSEs in Gross Domestic Product (GDP) is 6.18 %, 6.14 % and 5.85% respectively for the years 2010-11, 2011-12 and 2012-13. The percentage increase in turnover of CPSEs and GDP for the last three years is given below in (Table 1).

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(d) Performance improvement of CPSEs is a continuous process. Enterprise specific measures for their turn around are taken by the concerned administrative Ministries/ Departments and the CPSEs. The Board for Reconstruction of Public Sector Enterprises (BRPSE) which was set up by the Government in December 2004 considers and makes suitable recommendations on the revival/restructuring proposals relating to the sick/loss making CPSEs submitted by the concerned administrative Ministries/Departments.
