Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that commuters are being taxed twice viz. road tax and toll tax;
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government thereto along with the steps taken to rationalize the system;
- (c) whether there is a provision to increase toll tax every year; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor?

- (a) & (b) No, Madam. Road tax is a State subject and levied and collected by respective State Government. User fee is to be paid for use of Section of National Highways/Permanent Bridge/Temporary Bridge on National Highways.
- (c) Yes, Madam.
- (d) As per National Highways Fee (Determination of Rates and Collection) Rules, 2008 as amended user fee is to be revised annually. The rates of fee are increased without compounding by 3% each year from the 1st day of April. Additionally to neutralize impact of variable cost of operation and maintenance, 40% of annual increase of Wholesale Price Index (WPI) is provided.
