(a) & (b) Pursuant to Cabinet decision on17/05/2007, the Public Sector Banks were advised by the Government to step up their Minority Community Lending (MCL) to 15% of their Priority Sector Lending (PSL). In order to achieve the target of 15% to Minority Communities, PSBs have also been advised to open new branches in the Minority Dominated Areas.
