Will the Minister of TEXTILES be pleased to state:

- (a) whether lakhs of workers employed in textile mills are becoming unemployed due to closing of such mills in large scale in the country including Mumbai, Kanpur, Surat and Ujjain;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the present status of textile mills including Shri Synthetic Limited, Ujjain, Madhya Pradesh; Swadeshi Mill; Sayam- Chunabhatti, Mumbai; Matulya Mill, Andheri, Mumbai and Mukesh Mill, Thane, Maharashtra in the country?

- (a) & (b): As on 31.05.2015, there were 2,86,535 number of workers on the roll of 562 closed cotton/man-made fibre mills in the country. The number of workers on the rolls of cotton/man-made fibre mills located in Mumbai, Kanpur, Surat and Ujjain is as under:

(c): Shri Synthetic Limited Ujjain (Madhya Pradesh), manmade fibre/filament yarn manufacturing unit is lying closed since 27.08.2004. The three mills namely, (1) Swadeshi Mill Sayam-Chunabhati Mumbai, (2) Matulya Mill Andheri Mumbai, (3) Mukesh Mill Thane, Maharashtra are not in existence at present as they have been scrapped/dismantled after closure.
