## Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

(a) whether the non-operational airports in the country have incurred huge losses due to their maintenance and other expenses incurred thereon during the last three years;

(b) if so, the details of expenditure incurred on these non-operational airports during the said period, State/UT and airport-wise;

(c) whether the Government has any plan to make these airports operational: and

(d) if so, the steps taken by the Government in this regard and the time by which they are likely to made operational?

## Answer

Minister of CIVIL AVI ATION (Shri Ashok Gajapathi Raju Pusapati)

(a)& (b) : No, Madam. However, expenditure is being incurred on non- operational airports for maintaining some basic facilities. The details of such expenditure incurred on Non-operational airports during last three years are at Annexure-I.

(c) & (d): Development/upgradation of airports is a continuous process and is undertaken by the Airports Authority of India (AA1) from time to time depending on traffic demand, socio-economic considerations, availability of land etc.
