QUALITY TREATMENT IN GOVT. HOSPITALS

**Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether existing health system has been captured by private hospital operators in the country;
- (b) if so, reaction of the Govt, thereto along with the details of private hospitals/ diagnostic centres/clinics operational in the country, State/UT-wise; and
- (c) the remedial steps including providing quality treatment in Government hospitals taken/proposed to be taken by the Govt, in this regard?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRIJAGAT PRAKASH NADDA)

(a)to (c) : 'Health' being the State subject, information as such is not maintained centrally and it is the responsibility of the State Government to take remedial steps in this regard. However, as far as Institutions /Hospitals such as All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), New Delhi, Jawaharlal Institute of Postgraduate Medical Education and Research (JIPMER), Puducherry and three Central Government Hospitals in Delhi namely, Safdarjung Hospital, Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, Lady Hardinge Medical College and Associated Hospitals are concerned, quality treatment is provided in these hospitals with the help of trained manpower. Infrastructure and equipment are continuously upgraded as per need. Upgradation/modernization of these hospitals is a continuous process.
