- (a) the budgetary allocation made to the National AIDS Control Organisation (NACO) along with its utilization on various heads during each of the last three years and the current year, head and State/UT-wise;
- (b) the grants provided to various Non-Governmental Organisations (NGOs) and Voluntary Organisations (VOs) under the National AIDS Control Programme (NACP) in the country during the said period, State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has monitored and assessed the work and performance of these NGOs and VOs;
- (d) if so, the details of the irregularities and violation of norms noticed and the action taken/ proposed to be taken by the Government against the erring NGOs/VOs during the said period, State/ UT-wise; and
- (e) the measures being taken by the Government to improve the performance of NACP to achieve the targets set thereunder?

The evaluation is carried out once in 2 years by the respective States AIDS Control Society (SACS). SACS reviews the evaluation results and takes corrective steps based on the findings of the evaluation. For FY 2014-15 SACS have taken action basis the external and independent evaluation as follows:
