Will the Minister of SHIPPING be pleased to state:

- (a) whether certain problems in the execution of Mumbai Trans Harbour Sea Link Project to ease travel between Mumbai and the Satellite city of Navi Mumbai have been reported to the Government;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the action taken thereon;
- (c) whether there has been any delay in according approval to the aforesaid project;
- (d) if so, the details thereof along with the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which the project is likely to be approved and executed?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SHIPPING (SHRI PON. RADHAKRISHNAN)

(a)to(e):The project of Mumbai Trans Harbour Sea Link is being implemented by Mumbai Metropolitan Regional Development Authority (MMRDA) of Government of Maharashtra. The Ministry of Shipping is concerned with the request for Right of Way and lease of land for the project as the alignment of Mumbai Trans Harbour Link (MTHL) project is passing through Mumbai Port Trust (MbPT) and Jawaharlal Nehru Port Trust's (JNPT) water area and lands. Mumbai Port and JNPT have agreed for giving Right of Way and for leasing the land as per the provisions of the Land Policy Guidelines, 2014.
