- (a) the number of Sanskriti Schools functioning in the country at present along with the procedure of admissions in the said school;
- (b) whether various ministries and departments of Central Government provide any grants to Sanskriti School in Delhi;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for granting aid to this particular school;
- (d) whether the Government has requested the school to provide admission to students belonging to the general category; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(a):Madam, only one Sanskriti School is functioning in the country at present. The procedure of admission is as under:-

No screening test is conducted for Class Nursery to VIII and admission test is conducted for classes IX to XII.

(b)& (c):Sanskriti School is not being provided any grant by Ministries/Departments of the Central Government at present. Grants-in-aid was provided upto 2008-09 for Capital Expenditure. The details are at annexure `A`,

(d)& (c):Government has not requested the school to provide admission to students belonging to general category. As per the admission criteria of Sanskriti School, 10% seats are for general category.
