- (a) whether the Government has taken note of distribution of inferior quality of food items under Sabla Scheme being implemented for empowerment of adolescent girls in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; State/UT-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has formulated/proposes to formulate any policy to check it;
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor; and
- (e) the time by which a policy is likely to be formulated in this regard?

Answer

(a)& (b): Distribution of inferior quality of food items under the Sabla Scheme, being implemented for empowerment of adolescent girls in the country, has not been brought to the notice of the Government.

(c)to (e): Sabla, being a centrally sponsored Scheme is implemented by States/UTs in accordance with the guidelines of the scheme. Performance of the scheme is reviewed on a quarterly/annual basis for taking corrective measures. Also, Monitoring Committees set up at National, State, District, Block and Village level, review and monitor the implementation of the scheme including its supplementary nutrition component.
