- (c) the up to date status regarding use of Hindi keeping in view the targets fixed in the annual programme of the Department of official language;
- (d) whether original correspondence is made in Hindi in prescribed quantity under this and whether bilingual computers, Hindi Stenographers, Hindi typists are available in required percentage; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) As per available information, there are 127, 23 and 84 operational CPSEs in Regions "A", "B" & "C" respectively. State wise list of these Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) on 31.3.2014 with their names and addresses is placed at Annexure.
- (b) Details of CPSEs notified under the Official Language Rules 10 (4) are maintained by respective Administrative Ministries / Departments of CPSEs.
- (c) Status of use of Hindi in individual CPSEs against annual targets is maintained by respective Administrative Ministries / Departments.
- (d)&(e) The requirement of bilingual computers, Hindi Stenographers and Hindi Typists is decided as per annual programmes of CPSEs and their availability is monitored by respective Administrative Ministries/ Departments of CPSEs. Information regarding original correspondence made in Hindi in CPSEs is not maintained centrally in DPE.
