- (b) the details of CPSUs including Joint Venture Companies and Subsidiaries set up during the last two Five Year Plan periods and the status of their profit or loss, CPSUs-wise;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to establish more CPSUs in the current Five Year Plan; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Meghalaya?

- (a): As per information available in the Public Enterprises Survey 2013-14 that was laid in the Parliament on 26.02.2015, there were 290 Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) functioning in the country as on 31.03.2014. State-wise list of these 290 CPSEs is given in Annex 1.
- (b): The details of existing CPSEs including subsidiaries set up from April, 2007 onward and profit / loss reported by each of these CPSEs is given in Annex-2. The information on Joint Venture Companies is not maintained centrally.
- (c)and (d): The decision of setting up new CPSEs are taken by sectorial administrative Ministries based on the techno-economic considerations.
