- (a):There is no such scheme by the name of e-Visa in Government of India. However, Government recently introduced Tourist Visa on Arrival (TVoA) enabled with Electronic Travel Authorization (ETA) scheme to 44 countries. During last three (3) months 87610 TVoA-ETA have been issued by the Government of India.
- (b)& (c): The inclusion of additional countries is a continuous process which is done after appropriate consultation with all stake holders of Government of India.
