- (d) if so, the outcome thereof and the response of the Government thereto?

(a)to (d) There is no proposal for complete ban on the release of genetically modified organisms in the environment either for commercial cultivation or for experiments. The Government of India is following a policy of case by case approval of genetically modified (GM) crops. In view of various concerns related to the safety, efficacy and agronomic performance of transgenic seeds, extensive evaluation and regulatory approval process takes place before any GM plant is approved for commercial cultivation.
