(b) if so, the details thereof along with the number of such planes lying in operational during the last three years and the current year and the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to make all the planes of Air India operational?

(b): The average number of aircraft of Airbus A320 family fleet available during the last three years and the current year (up to October 2015) is given below:

Some aircraft were not available due to various reasons like,- scheduled maintenance checks, unscheduled maintenance such as bird hit, air/ground incident/ accident, snag rectification, non-availability of spares/ engines and inspections for lease return.

(c): Air India has raised ECB of USD 300 million with Government guarantee for procurement of spares for maintenance of aircraft.
