- (c) & (d) The Government received a proposal seeking financial support for setting up a National Biodiversity Garden and Traditional Knowledge Centre in Munnar region of Idukki District, Kerala to conserve the endemic biodiversity, at a cost of Rs. 25.638 crores for 4 years. The proposal was forwarded to the National Biodiversity Authority for consideration under the provisions of Biological Diversity Act.
