- (d) whether these parks are maintained properly and if not, the reasons therefor along with the action taken/ being taken by the Government in this regard;
- (e) whether the Government proposes to outsource the maintenance of DDA parks to the private parties and if so, the details thereof and the amount likely to be spent in this regard; and
- (f) whether any prior study was conducted on the cost benefit analysis before handing over such contract and if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

(b): DDA has informed that the number of saplings planted and their survival rate after one year of their plantation during the last two years is as under:

2013-14	1,46,845	70%
2014-15	1,33,226	71%

(c): DDA has informed that the details of funds incurred on maintenance of these parks during the last two years and current year is as under:

2014-15	296.71
2015-16 (upto Oct, 2015)	148.65
