- (c) whether the Government has shortlisted the trains and stations on which painting is likely to be done and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Railways proposes to collaborate with WWF in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the time by which the work of painting the coaches and stations is likely to be started and completed?
