- (a) whether a foundation stone for 200 beds hospital had been laid at Madipur in West Delhi in the recent past;
- (b) if so, the details and the present status thereof; and
- (c) the time by which construction of the said hospital is likely to be started?

Answer

(a) to (c): Yes. Government of NCT of Delhi has informed that building plans for this hospital have been approved by statutory authorities like Delhi Urban Arts Commission (DUAC), Chief Fire Officer (CFO), Airport Authority of India (AAI), Municipal Corporation of Delhi (MCD), etc. Health Department, Government of NCT of Delhi is seized of the matter in connection with examination of preliminary estimates of Rs.180 crores for this hospital project. No time frame can be given as administrative approval of the project is yet to be accorded.
