(a) & (b): State-wise details of complete proposals received during the current year for inclusion of castes etc. in the list of Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Central List of Other Backward Classes (OBCs) are as under:-

(c): As any amendment in the list of SCs can be done only by an Act of Parliament in view of clause (2) of Article 341 of the Constitution of India, no time frame can be assigned in the matter. In respect of Central Lists of OBCs inclusion of castes/communities is a continuous process.
