(a) to (d): The Ministry is in the process of making a policy to incentivise people to bring their old vehicles for scrapping. A letter has been written to the Ministry of Finance on 20.01.2016 to intimate if an incentive in the form of reduction of excise duty on the purchase of new vehicle can be given.
