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Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of Industrial Training Institutes (ITIs) functioning and the number of students trained in these ITIs during the last one year;
- (b) whether the Prime Minister"s Office has directed to open 7000 new ITIs within one year and if so, the details thereof and the objective behind the move;
- (c) whether his Ministry is exploring the possibility of offering soft loans to private players to open ITIs and if so, the response of private players in this regard;
- (d) whether the Government is also in touch with some private education providers under the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) for exploring the possibility of opening ITIs and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the other steps taken/being taken by the Government to open new ITIs for giving training to more students so that they become more self-reliant?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJIV PRATAP RUDY)

- (a) At present a total number of 13,105 Industrial Training Institutes ITIs (Govt. 2293 &Pvt. 10812) are functioning in the Country. Statewise details of ITIs with seating capacities are placed at Annex–I. Duration of trades in ITIs varies from 06 months to 2 years. As per information available on National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) web portal 9,37,809 trainees in year 2014 and 10,73,265 trainees in year 2015 were admitted.
- (b) Prime Minister's Office has given mandate of opening of 7000 new ITIs within one year with the objective of enhancing seating capacities in ITIs from existing 18.65 Lakhs to 25 Lakhs.
- (c) At present, no such scheme regarding offering of soft loans to private players to open ITIs has been formulated.
- (d) Directorate General of Training (DGT), Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship is in the process of framing guidelines to utilize the infrastructural facilities of existing and closed Engg. colleges,& polytechnics etc to run Craftsmen Training Scheme (C.T.S) under the aegis of National Council for Vocational Training (NCVT) in consultation with All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE).
- (e) DGT is in the process of bringing more number of institutes under NCVT by upgrading:
- ITIs running under State Council for Vocational Training (SCVT) to NCVT
- Vocational Training Provider (VTP) under other schemes to NCVT
- Training institutes running under Military training to NCVT
- Training institutes running under Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) to NCVT.
