FISHING PORTS

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has carried out any survey to identify fishing ports which lack infrastructure and other facilities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has received proposals from various States for survey of fishing ports in certain coastal States; and
- (d) if so, the details of proposals submitted for establishment of new fishing ports during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR AGRICULTURE AND FOOD PROCESSING INDUSTRIES (DR. SANJEEV KUMAR BALYAN)

(a) and (b) : The Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries, Ministry of Agriculture through one of its subordinate offices, namely, Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery(CICEF), Bangalore provides technical assistance to the Coastal State Governments and Union Territories(UTs) for conduct of pre-investment studies to identify potential sites for development as fishing harbours and fish landing centres along the country's coast. Besides, the Department, through the Institute, also provides technical assistance to the needy Coastal States/UTs for conduct of necessary engineering and economic investigations and formulation of Techno Economic Feasibility Reports (TEFRs) and Detailed Project Reports(DPRs) for construction of fishing harbour and fish landing centres.

(c) and (d) : During the past three financial years (2011-12 to 2013-14) and also current year (2014-15), requests have been received from various Coastal State Governments namely, Gujarat, Maharashtra, Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh, Odisha, Kerala and UT of Puducherry. The CICEF, Bangalore has been extending necessary technical assistance to these needy States for conduction of necessary surveys and formulation of proposals. State-wise proposal received in this regard are as below:
