- (a) whether as per guidelines, civilians and shopkeepers are not allowed to wear or sell combat uniforms in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government is aware that shops are selling military fatigues, boots and berets freely in various parts of the country;
- (d) if so, the action taken/being taken by the Government against the guilty shopkeepers; and
- (e) the further steps taken/being taken by the Government to create awareness among the people in this regard?
