(a) to (e): Government of India is implementing a number of programmes/schemes for increasing agriculture production through State Governments, including Rajasthan. Crop developments programmes, such as National Food Security Mission (NFSM), National Mission on Oilseeds and Oil Palm (NMOOP), Mission for Integrated Development of Horticulture (MIDH), Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) provide assistance for activities like demonstrations of improved technologies, distribution of improved seeds/planting material, need based plant protection and soil amendments, resource conservation techniques, efficient water application tools, protected cultivation, farmers' trainings, etc. for enhancing agricultural production.

Allocations for State of Rajasthan for 2014-15 for these schemes are:

(Rs. in crore) S.No. Scheme Allocation 1. NFSM 220.40 2. NMOOP 50.85 3. RKVY 740.55 4. MIDH 89.25

The States are allocated funds under various programmes on the basis of the criteria prescribed. The funds are released to the States on receipt of action plans/proposals and progress in implementation.
