(a) to (d) Madam, Government is already issuing licenses from the year 2002 for providing internet telephone service. As on 29.02.2016, there are 817 Telecom Licensees which are permitted to provide internet telephone services. As per "The Indian Telecom Services Performance Indicators" report issued by Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) for Quarter ending September'2015, 18 (eighteen) telecom service providers have reported providing internet telephony services. The list of these telecom service providers is enclosed as Annexure-I.
