(a) to (c): Representations have been received from time to time from various farmers' organizations requesting for increase in Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) of various crops

Government fixes Minimum Support Prices (MSPs) based on the recommendations of Commission for Agricultural Costs & Prices (CACP), Ministries/ departments and other relevant factors.

Government offers procurement at Minimum Support Price (MSP). However, farmers are free to sell in the open market if the market offers higher price than MSP.
