- (a) whether the National Agricultural Cooperative Marketing Federation of India (NAFED) has any proposal to revise the procurement price of copra;
- (b) if so, the present rate fixed by NAFED for procurement of copra per kg. from the farmers ensures remunerative price to them?
- (c) whether the Government has any proposal to revise and fix support price of copra to Rs. 100/- per kg. from the current rate; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

- (a) & (b): Government of India fixes Minimum Support Price (MSP) for Copra taking into account the recommendations of Commission for Agricultural Costs & Prices (CACP) and the views of the State Governments as well as such other relevant factors which are considered important for fixation of support prices. NAFED procures Copra at Minimum Support Price fixed by the Government. The present MSP in respect of Fair & Average Quality of Milling Copra and Ball Copra is Rs.5250/- and Rs.5500/- per quintal, respectively.
