- (b) if so, whether the Government is importing milk to cater to the needs of the country; and
- (c) if so, the steps taken by the Government to improve the milk production and to achieve self- sufficiency in milk/dairy sector?

- (a) & (b) No, Madam. The production of milk has been increasing. Milk Production in the last three years was 121.8 Million Tonnes in 2010-11, 127.9 Million Tonnes in 2011-12 and 132.4 Million Tonnes in 2013-14. The Government is not importing milk to cater to the needs of the country.
- (c) Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries, Government of India is implementing following schemes to increase the milk production and to maintain self-sufficiency in milk/dairy sector:
- (1) National Programme for Bovine Breeding and Dairy Development
- (2) National Dairy Plan-Phase I
- (3) Dairy Entrepreneurship Development Scheme
- (4) Livestock Health and Disease Control
- (5) National Livestock Mission
