Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is no Kendriya Vidyalaya in Madhubani district in Bihar despite having a large population;
 - (b) whether the Government proposes to set up a Kendriya Vidyalaya in the said area;
 - (c) if so, the time by when it is likely to be set up and if not, the reasons therefor;
 - (d) whether the Government is aware that the Kendriya Vidyalaya in Sheohar District of Bihar do not have any building and is functioning from some other school building and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
 - (e) the date since when the Kendriya Vidyalaya is functioning from the said building;

- (f) the details of action taken/proposed to be taken by the Government for construction of their building in the said area along with the likely date of completion of the construction?

Answer

- (a) to (c): There is no Kendriya Vidyalaya (KV) in Madhubani District of Bihar. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered if those are sponsored by Ministries/Department of the Government of India or State Governments / Union Territories Administrations or Organization of employees belonging to the eligible categories thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV, and are subject to availability of resources with the Central Government. No proposal has been received so far from the State Government or District Administration for setting up a new KV in Madhubani District.
- (d) to (f): KV, Sheohar is functioning from a temporary accommodation provided by the District Administration in Kalawati Jiyalal High School at Ambakala w.e.f. 01.04.2008. The construction work of the permanent building for KV, Sheohar was entrusted to CPWD in June, 2012. The progress of construction work so far is 70% and the permanent building is likely to be completed during the academic session 2016-17.
