(a) Yes Madam.

(b) Department of Animal Husbandry, Dairying & Fisheries had approved four projects covering ten districts namely Central Bastar, Raigarh, Ambikapur, Korea, Kawardha, Jashpur, Raipur, Rajnandgaon, Mahasamund & Dhamtari under 'Intensive Dairy Development Programme' (IDDP) in Chhattisgarh with total approved outlay of Rs.3036.40 lakh. An amount of Rs.1772.61 lakh has been released upto 31.03.2014, leaving unspent balance of Rs.649.16 lakh with Implementing Agency. Out of the four, one project covering Central Bastar district of the State has been completed.

Intensive Dairy Development Programme (IDDP) alongwith other two dairy development scheme has now been merged in new Scheme 'National Programme for Bovine Breeding and Dairy Development'(NPBBDD) since February,2014
