iii. Delhi State ST - 1
iv. All India ST - 1
v. PH - 3
vi. Balance seats are reserved for war widows, wards of serving/retired army persons/war widows
```

(c): Presently, there is no proposal before the Ministry of Health & FW to increase the number of seats for the children of non-defence personnel in Army College of Medical Sciences, Delhi.
