Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of MBBS seats allocated to the Army College of Medical Sciences, Delhi for the current academic year as compared to the last academic year;
- (b) the number of seats reserved for the children of defence personnel in the said college during the said period; and
- (c) whether the Government propose to increase the number of seats for children of non-defence personnel in the said college, if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

Answer

THE MINISTER OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. HARSH VARDHAN)

(a) & (b): Army College of Medical Sciences, Delhi has an intake capacity of 100 MBBS seats and the reservation of seats is as under.

- i. Delhi State SC category - 14
- ii. All India SC category - 2
- iii. Delhi State ST - 1
- iv. All India ST - 1
- v. PH - 3
- vi. Balance seats are reserved for war widows, wards of serving/retired army persons/war widows

(c): Presently, there is no proposal before the Ministry of Health & FW to increase the number of seats for the children of non-defence personnel in Army College of Medical Sciences, Delhi.
