- (c) the expenditure incurred on the maintenance and upkeep of these memorials and monuments during the above period; and
- (d) whether there is any proposal to install a statue of Mahatama Gandhi at India Gate in New Delhi and if so, the details thereof and the progress made in this regard?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 516 TO BE ANSWERED ON 13.08.2014 REGARDING URBAN BEAUTIFICATION

- (a): Conservation work of protected monuments of National importance in the country, including NCT of Delhi is a continuous process and attended to as per National Conservation Policy of the Archaeological Survey of India (ASI). The essential repair work and maintenance of these monuments is executed regularly depending upon the availability of resources and requirements of different sites.
- (b): The NCT of Delhi has reported that no new statues/memorials were installed/erected during the last three years and current year.
- (c): Maintenance and upkeep of memorials and monuments is a continuous process and expenditure is dependent on available budget with each client department. No such data is maintained centrally.
- (d): At present there is no such proposal under consideration.
