## Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government is aware that various posts of non-teaching staff are laying vacant in some Central Universities particularly in the School of Open Learning under Delhi University despite the availability of eligible candidates;
(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor and the remedial steps taken by the Government in this regard; and
(c) the time by which these are likely to be filled up?


#### Abstract

Answer MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SMT. SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI) (a) to (c): The University Grants Commission(UGC) has informed that out of 34,272 sanctioned non-teaching posts in 39 Central Universities under the purview of UGC, including School of Open Learning under University of Delhi, 10,015 non-teaching posts are lying vacant as on 1.1.2016. Occurring of vacancies and filling them is a continuous process. Ministry of Human Resource Development and UGC have repeatedly urged Central Universities to fill up the vacancies. However, the onus of filling up the nonteaching posts lies on Central Universities which are autonomous bodies created under Acts of Parliament.
