- (c) The number of proposals still pending and the reasons for such pendency along with the time by which these pending proposals are likely to be cleared?

- (b): As per National Urban Transport Policy, 2006 the Government of India offers financial support subject to a ceiling of 20% of the capital cost of the project. The details of proposals cleared and the funds sanctioned and released during the last three years and current year is given in Annexure I.
- (c): Appraisal and approval of the proposals are a continuous process wherein the Ministry of Urban Development seeks comments of various stakeholders. The proposals which are in the process of appraisal/approval are Ahmedabad, Nagpur, Lucknow, Extension of Chennai Metro; Noida City Centre to Sector 62, Noida; Noida City Centre to Greater Noida; Dilshad Garden to New Bus Adda, Ghaziabad; YMCA Chowk, Faridabad to Ballabhgarh, Haryana and Kalindi Kunj to Botanical Garden.
