**Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Government proposes to construct a bridge on river Yamuna on the road leading to Uttar Pradesh from Gumthala village in Radaur, Haryana;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether construction of the said bridge is necessary to safeguard against flood in this area of Haryana, if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether any targets have been fixed for construction of National Highways in the country during the year 2015-16; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

**Answer**

- (a) to (c) No madam. The road leading to Uttar Pradesh from village Gumthala in Radaur, Haryana is a state road and not a National Highway. Therefore, this does not pertain to Ministry of Road Transport and Highways, Government of India. Further, Construction of bridge will not help much in safeguarding against flood.
- (d) & (e) Yes madam. Construction of 6300 Km length of National Highways was targeted during the year 2015-16.
