- (a) whether the Union Government has launched National Food Security Mission (NFSM) to increase the production of rice, wheat and pulses and if so, the extent to which the production of rice, wheat and pulses has been increased thereafter;
- (b) whether the Union Government has conducted midterm evaluation to assess the impact of the programme in increasing the productivity of rice, wheat, pulses and enhancement of farm income and if so, the findings thereof;

- (e) whether the NFSM is implemented in all the districts of the country, if so, the details thereof?

(a): Yes, Madam. Government of India has launched National Food Security Mission (NFSM) in 2007-08 to increase production of rice, wheat and pulses. The details of increase in production of rice, wheat and pulses during XI Plan are as under:

- (b) to (d): Yes, Madam. Mid-term and final evaluation of National Food Security Mission (NFSM) for 11th Five Year Plan has been conducted by an independent agency and reports have been received.
