- (c) & (d) Prasar Bharati has informed that AIR has not fixed any timeframe for commissioning of these technically ready radio stations. Prasar Bharati has already taken initiatives for exploring the possibilities for commissioning of these stations by transferring staff from other stations or deploying retired staff of AIR/Doordarshan on contractual basis.
