Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of units of Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) functionings in the country at present along with the number of employment opportunities generated therefrom; State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether the Government has received any proposal from various States including Madhya Pradesh regarding setting up of new KVIC units;
- (c) if so, the details along with current status thereof; State/UT-wise; and
- (d) the number of KVIC units set up and the number of employment generated therefrom during each of the last three years and current year; State/UT-wise?

(a)to(d): Government is implementing a major credit linked subsidy programme namely, Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) for establishment of micro enterprises in the non-farm sector. Khadi & Village Industries Commission (KVIC) is the nodal agency for implementing PMEGP at the national level. The State/UT-wise units set up and functioning in the country at present alongwith the number of employment opportunities generated therefrom, is given at Annexure-I.

State/UT-wise targets, including the State of Madhya Pradesh, are fixed for establishment of new units under PMEGP. Units are set up by the unemployed youth wherein KVIC provides subsidy on loan availed by the entrepreneurs through public sector banks. Number of units proposed for the year 2016-17 is given at Annexure-II.

The PMEGP units set up in the country and employment generated during each of the last three years and current year; State/UT-wise is given at Annexure-III.
